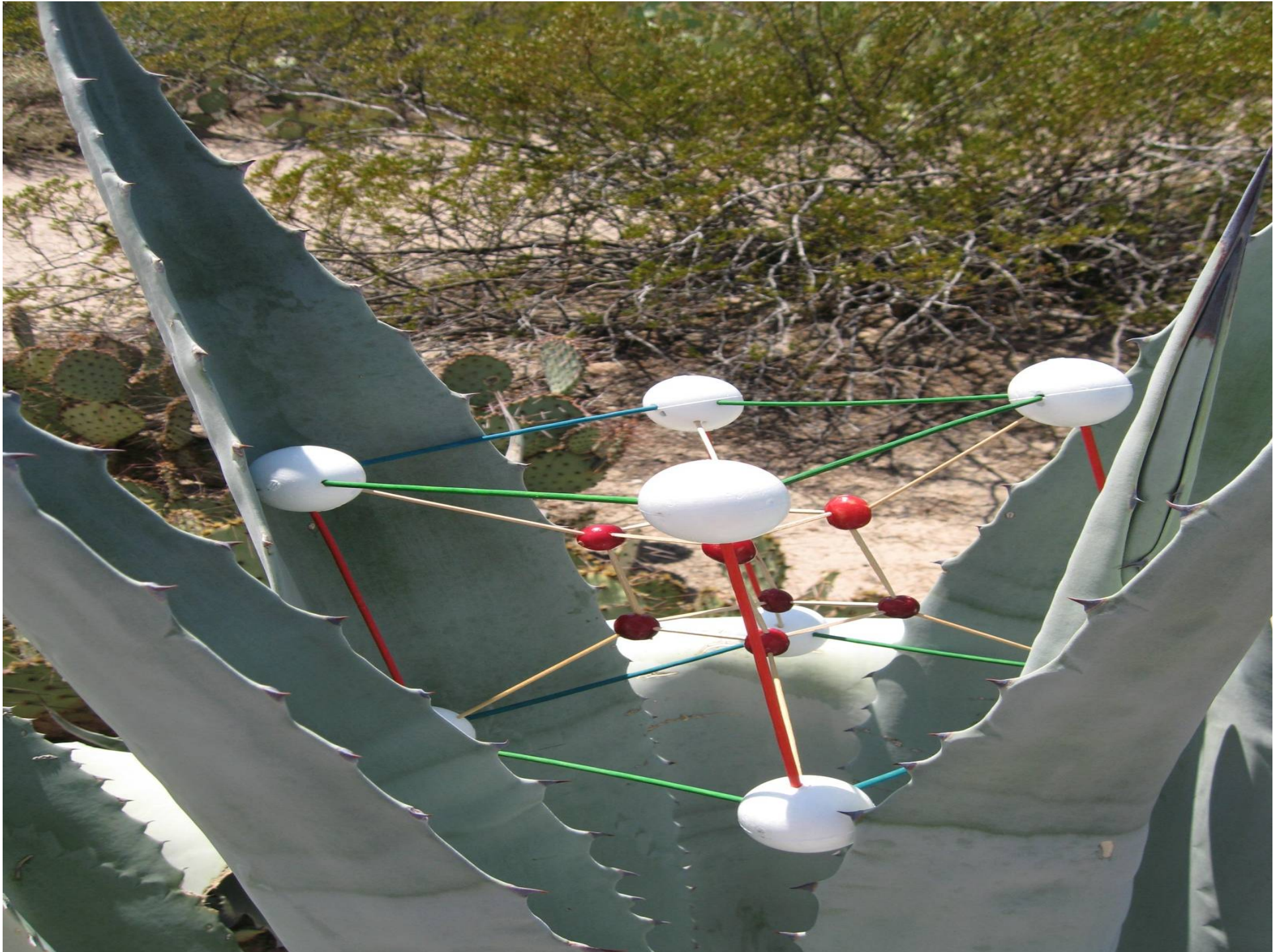


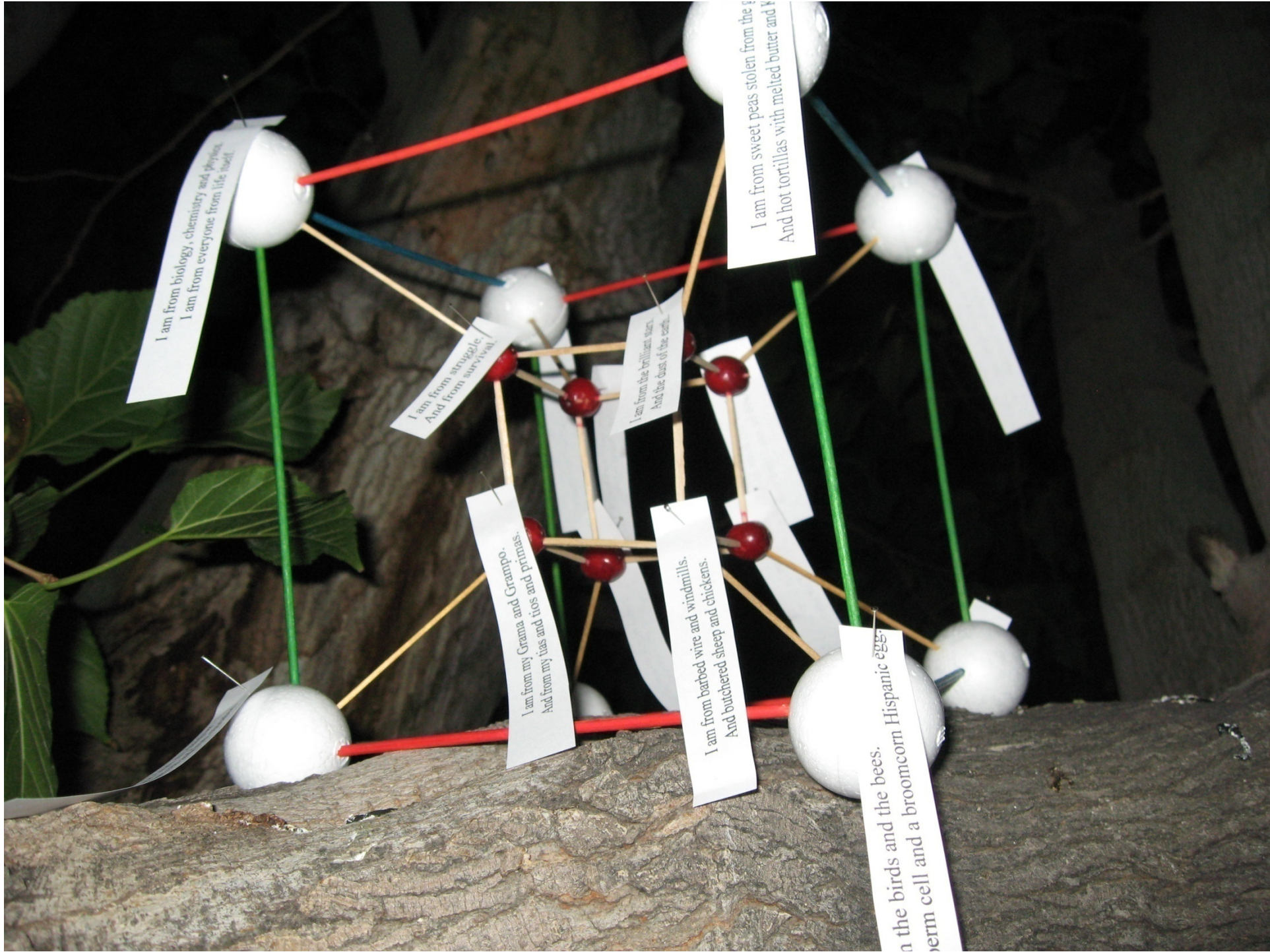












I am from biology, chemistry and physics.
