ACT 1: Susie-Q song plays

- Stage Plot: Red Curtain is closed. Ernest does his opener, and then Susi-Q song plays, as Ernest introduces the actors, as they dance, one at a time, in front of curtain, downstage

Introduction of performers intended to start with humor and performance roles in front of the RED CURTAIN.

ACT 2: VIVA LAS VEGAS:

Opens with Dr. David Boje introducing the Subject of the Care and Treatment of Mental Patients in New Mexico. Act centers on the discharge process, and the options available of where they can choose to go when They leave the New Mexico Behavioral Health Institute, Located in Las Vegas NM. The Institution has gone through two name changes, and I think it would be interesting if in your narration you list the first two names of the Institution. Originally it was called "the Territorial Insane Asylum", then it became the "New Mexico Hospital for the Insane", now it is called the "New Mexico Behavioral Health Institute". It is the only State owned mental institute in NM. The only way to get in is to be Court Ordered Commitment by a Judge in good standing in the state of New Mexico and transported there in a police car by a a court bailiff.

b. Treatments: With Bob playing the role of a Doctor who is handing out treatment options. The Patients will be introduced pagent style with Bob dramatizing there Mental Illnesses, for example: "This is James Sassak who suffers from SCHIZOPHRENIA, He is plagued by voices in his head that just won't shut up" (we will burst into song 'when the voices in your head say your better off dead TAKE ZYPREXA'. Arron will be Bipolar "Arron suffers from Manic Depressive mood swings that make his life unmanageble". Glenn will be Suicidal. the Patients will Spin a wheel of fortune that has different treatments on it. The treatments will consist of nice things like, Lobotomy, Electric Shock Therapy, and Drugged out your mind. More to come as Act develops. For the one who spins the wheel and it lands on Lobotomey we will use a drill to perform the Lobotomy. More to come as Act develops.

c. Discharge: With Bob playing the role of a Doctor who is discharging several patients at once. The Patients take turns spinning a wheel of fortune that we will construct. On the Wheel there are destinations such as Hawaii and New York, but is rigged to always land on Las Cruces. So the Patients will spin the wheel and get excited only to be let down when the wheel constantly lands on Las Cruces. Patients will complain but take the only option open to them, all except for Glenn who will be the last one who is supposed to spin the wheel will instead grab a Knife and threaten to kill himself in a bid to stay a interned at the Institution rather than face homelessness in Las Cruces.

ACT 3: CODE ENFORCEMENT IN LAS VEGAS NEW MEXICO, THOSE PEOPLE ARE NOT WELCOME

This act can be done just as you have written it, will follow Viva Las Vegas and continue the story.


